

RULES AND REGULATIONS MEMBERSHIP AND ADMISSION

1. Members – Subscribers of \$15.00 shall be members of the Society and entitled to vote at all meetings, and to receive one member's and two complimentary tickets of admission. Complimentary Ticket covers one adult or two children under 14 years.
Exhibitors in sections must be subscribers to the funds of the Society, as hereinafter provided: Sections A, B, B(7), C and E not less than \$15.00.
2. Admission to ground – Adults \$7.00, Pensioners \$5.00 (Pens. Conc. Cards only), Children under 14 years \$2.00, Children under 5 years Free.
3. Persons wishing to leave the Grounds and desiring re-admittance must obtain a 'pass out' at the gate.
4. Entries in all classes should be made on the forms provided by the Society, and addressed to the Secretary, to be received not later than the time specified. Exhibitors are kindly requested to enter early. **No Late Entries Accepted – No Phone Entries.** The Secretary will not be responsible for any inaccuracies which may occur if the foregoing provisions are not complied with.
5. All subscriptions and entrance fees must be paid when entries are made.
6. All dairy cattle must be the registered bonafide property of the exhibitor and must be exhibited as Registered in the Stud Book or the Appendix Section of the relevant breed society or held by the exhibitor under a written and recorded lease at time of entry.
7. All entries are accepted subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Society.
8. All livestock exhibits must be on the grounds by 9.00 am on the morning of the show.
9. Exhibitors of Works of Art (especially Pictures) are requested to forward their exhibits to the hall before noon on the Saturday prior to the show, to facilitate the hanging or arranging thereof. Photographs to be forwarded before 3pm on the Wednesday prior to the show.
10. Any exhibit entered in the E.A. Affiliated Hack Ring height classes must carry a current. E.A. measurement certificate and are only eligible to compete in the respective height class according to the height on the measurement certificate. Failure to produce certificate upon request will result in exhibit being withdrawn from the consideration of the Judge.

11. No prize will be awarded unless an exhibit be deemed worthy by the judges, who may award second and third prizes in lieu of first and second. In all cases their decision shall be final. The Judges may withhold prizes in any classes, without assigning any reasons therefore.
13. The Judges are empowered to decide on the age of any animal.
14. No entries shall be made by two or more persons unless all such persons shall each be a member of the Society. This shall not apply to a registered firm.
15. Champion prizes will be awarded to the best exhibits to be selected by the Judges from animals entered in the Section.
16. The Committee may withhold all or any prizes won by an exhibitor not complying with the conditions.
17. Should any exhibit, having gained a prize, be disqualified, the next on the list does not necessarily obtain the prize, unless so decided by the Committee.
18. Any exhibit which, in the opinion of the Committee, has been fraudulently or wrongly entered, may be disqualified, and the exhibitor disqualified from taking any prizes at the Show at which such exhibit has been so fraudulently or wrongfully entered. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse to accept any entry, or having received the same, to refuse to allow the exhibit to compete without assigning any reasons therefore.
19. Any owner, rider or exhibitor (in any section) refusing to obey any reasonable order of the Steward in charge may have his or her exhibit withdrawn by the Steward from the consideration of the Judge, and be disqualified from further competing at the Show.
20. Except where otherwise stipulated, no exhibits shall be removed from the ground till 4.30pm; nor from the hall till 4.30pm.
21. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, mis-delivery, or damage of exhibits at the Society's exhibition.
22. The ruling of the Committee on any disputed point to be final.
23. Any person proved to the satisfaction of the Committee to have been guilty of any fraudulent or discreditable conduct in connection with any entry form or exhibit, or of using any abusive or unseemly remarks to a Judge or Official may, in addition to forfeiting all prize-money awarded at the show at which such conduct may occur, be declared incapable of competing for or winning any prizes at any Show held by this Society for such period as the Committee may decide.

24. All protests must be made to the Secretary, in writing within half hour of completion of judging of section. Each protest to be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00, which shall be forfeited to the Society should the protest be deemed frivolous. A sub-committee appointed to the Executive prior to the show and to include the convenor of the section in which the dispute has occurred shall hear the dispute on the day of the Show (if practical). There may be an appeal from any such decision to the General Committee of the Society.
25. Members and Non-Members are invited to add to the attraction of the Show by exhibiting anything rare or choice without admission fee subject to approval by the Executive Committee.
26. Trade Space exhibitors can obtain space by application to the Secretary on payment of a fee. Two tickets will be sent on payment of this fee.
27. Space for side-shows will only be allotted at the discretion of the Committee on payment of fees, which may be claimed for in advance.
28. No truck or trailer used for the transporting of livestock, including Poultry/Pigeons to be parked inside the showground. Vehicles used for transporting horses to be parked in the allotted area.
29. All **PRIZE MONIES** not collected on the day will be forfeited.
30. Any **TROPHIES** not collected within 14 days of Show will be forfeited.
31. Any exhibits from properties within the proclaimed branched Broom Rape quarantine zone, or from out of zone properties infested with this weed, must be accompanied by a statutory declaration and appropriate certificate of approval .
