Strathalbyn, Langhorne Creek, Milang, Clayton, Ashbourne, Finnis and Woodchester
- Please nominate garden on entry form and forward to convenor, together with entry fee by closing date.
- If property is hard to locate, submit plan with entry form.
- A Rosette will be presented to the Best Garden in each town with 5 or more gardens entered.
- Out of the eight classes listed below, the best garden in each category of each town will receive a special certificate and ribbon. On being judged the best garden of its class, the garden will then be eligible to enter in the Champion garden of the Strathalbyn District.
